It is a problem that is affecting the lives of many, and it is a problem that is increasing. GMPA and GMP are determined to tackle this nuisance... are you?

Off-Road vehicles include:

Motocross, trial and enduro bikes; quad bikes, electric scooters; buzzboards and gopeds; and any other mechanically propelled vehicle which is built for use off-road and should not be used on public roads and pavements or in public spaces.

Nuisance can be caused by off-road vehicles being illegally driven in any public place or by road-registered vehicles being inappropriately driven off-road.

GMPA Campaign

Off-Road Vehicle Registration Scheme

The issue of off-road motorcycle nuisance has been identified as an area of public concern via public consultation, and GMPA identified that a registration scheme would be a useful tool to help combat the growing problem of anti-social behaviour related to the illegal use of off-road motorcycles.

The primary aim of the off-road scrutiny project being undertaken by the authority therefore, is to achieve the establishment of a mandatory, retrospective and continuous off-road registration scheme as the authority believe that it will deliver the following benefits:

Increased enforcement powers for the criminal justice system

A registration scheme would establish the registered keeper and identify the bike at first contact.

Reduction in the illegal stolen off-road motorcycle market

A registration scheme would also allow easier prosecution of those found to be handling stolen goods e.g. in possession of motorcycles without documentation.

Improvements to police intelligence

If a report of off-road motorcycle nuisance is received, a description of the bike would be able to be used to search for similar bikes registered in the local area, therefore improving the likelihood of identifying the perpetrator.

Consumer Protection

Currently consumers have no way of knowing whether or not they are buying stolen property, as there are no requirements to provide documentation. A registration scheme would ensure that keeper records were logged and traceable.
